- 10.55 Spur, slopes S. 65° W.; asc. 45 ft. over SW. slope.
- 14.20 Head of ravine, drains W.; asc. 20 ft. over SW. slope.
- 16.95 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course S. 50° W.; asc. 60 ft. over SW. slope.
- 19.88 A corner established by William A. Eimstad, Registered Land Surveyor, No. 377, in 1979, monumented with an iron rod, 5/8 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 2 ins. above ground, from which bearing trees mkd. by Eimstad
 - A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears N. 68° E., 18 1/2 lks. dist., with scribe marks N 1/16 S27 BT visible on open blaze.
 - A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears N. 21° W., 26 lks. dist., with scribe marks N 1/16 S28 BT visible on open blaze.
- Ascend 195 ft. over SW. slope.
- 29.50 Spur, slopes S. 75° W.; desc. 205 ft. over NW. slope.
- 39.76 The cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28, perpetuated and recorded by James W. Byron, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1958, monumented with an iron post, 1 1/4 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 16 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir snag, 58 ins. diam., bears N. 68° E., 9 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on opened blaze and scribe marks S22 BT visible on bark. (Record, N. 68° W.)

A root hole, bears S. 46° E., 43 lks. dist., with a downed fir alongside, size indeterminate, no marks visible.

A maple root crown, bears S. 29° W., 52 lks. dist., no marks visible.

A grand fir, 23 ins. diam., bears N. 50° E., 13 1/2 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

A grand fir, 22 ins. diam., bears S. 60° E., 59 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A maple, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 30° W., 55 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 71 1/2° W., 28 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.
