CHAINS

The following field notes are those of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, Township 26 South, Range 8 West, Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

The history of surveys pertaining to this resurvey is as follows:

The south boundary of the township was surveyed by Addison R. Flint and Samuel C. Flint, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1881.

The subdivisional lines of the township were surveyed by William P. Heydon, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1896, with field corrections made in 1898.

The south boundary of the township was concurrently resurveyed by Harvey E. Wofford and John P. Farnsworth under Group Nos. 981 and 1065 and is described in the field notes of Township 27 South, Range 8 West, of that assignment.

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, and the Special Instructions dated May 12, 1981, for Group No. 1065, Oregon.

The directions of the lines refer to the true meridian as determined by deflection angles from azimuths obtained by direct solar observation.

Preliminary to the resurvey, the lines of the original survey were retraced and search was made for all corners and other calls of the record. Identified corners were remonumented in their original positions. The retrace-ment data were thoroughly verified and only the true line field notes are given herein. All lines not forming a closure were measured twice to preclude error. Only those lines bounding or crossing public lands were blazed.

The geographic position of the corner of sections 3, 4, 33, and 34, Tps. 26 and 27 S., R. 8 W., as scaled from the United States Geological Survey topographic map, "TYEE, OREG.", 15 minute series, prepared in 1955, is as follows:

Latitude: 43° 15.5' N. Longitude: 123° 38.6' W.

The mean magnetic declination is 18° E.
