CHAINS

N. 89° 31' W., on the N. bdy. of sec. 1.

Descend 55 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

The cor. of Tps. 29 S., Rs. 9 and 10 W., described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the S. bdy. of T. 29 S., R. 10 W., executed concurrently under these same groups and Group No. 1067.

From this point, United States Coast and Geodetic Survey triangulation station "CAMAS 2 1942", bears N. 80° 53' 30" E., 177.11 chs. dist., monumented with a standard brass tablet, 3 1/2 ins. diam., set in a concrete post, 9 x 9 ins. sq., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above ground, mkd. CAMAS 2 1942.

N. 0° 27' E., bet. secs. 31 and 32.

Ascend 55 ft. over SW. slope, through moderate timber and dense undergrowth.

Foot of rock bluff, bears E. and W.; asc. 65 ft.

1.40

Top of rock bluff; asc. 40 ft. over rocky SW. slope.

2.75

Top of ascent, slopes SW.; desc. 10 ft. over broken W. slope.

4.60

Creek, 4 lks. wide, course S. 40° W.; asc. 215 ft. over broken SE. slope.

33.95

Edge of timber, bears E. and W.; enter logged area.

40.54

The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 32, determined from the remains of the original bearing trees

A fir stump, 23 ins. diam., bears N. 67° E., 29 lks. dist., with no marks visible on decayed blaze.

A fir stump, 23 ins. diam., bears N. 75° W., 10 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an aluminum post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.
