A hemlock, 20 ins. diam. bears N. 73° W., 64 1/2
lks. dist.; with scribe marks T20S R12W S3 MC
BT visible on partially healed blaze.

and a new bearing tree

A hemlock, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 75° W., 58 1/2
lks. dist., mkd. T20S R12W S10 MC BT.

N. 89° 31' W., beginning new measurement.

dist., with scribe marks MC S10 BT visible
on partially healed blaze.

A hemlock, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 67° W., 58 lks.
dist., mkd. T20S R12W S3 MC BT.
