CHAINS

N. 44° 25' W., 3.16 chs. At 0.795 chs. dist., intersect the adjusted meanders of the west shore of Tahkenitch Lake.

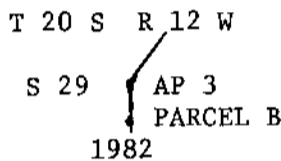
N. 58° 02' W., 1.13 chs.

N. 86° 14' W., 1.51 chs.

S. 55° 43' W., 1.245 chs.

S. 34° 27' W., 3.175 chs. At end of course, intersect the 80 ft. easterly right-of-way of U.S. Highway No. 101, point for Angle Point No. 3 of Parcel B.

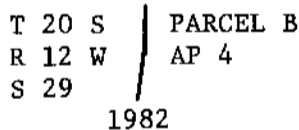
Set an aluminum post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.



Set a steel fence post alongside aluminum post.

Thence southerly on line 3-4 of Parcel B, along the 80 ft. easterly right-of-way of U.S. Highway No. 101, on a 3° 47' circular curve to the right, an arc distance of 1.976 chs. (130.4 ft.), the long chord of which bears S. 1° 55' W., 1.975 chs. dist. (130.4 ft.), to point of curve, and point for Angle Point No. 4, of Parcel B.

Set an aluminum post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 38 3/4° E., 37 lks. dist., mkd. AP 4 PAR B BT.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 88 1/4° W., 13 1/2 lks. dist., mkd. AP S29 BT.

Set a steel fence post alongside aluminum post.

Thence S. 4° 23' W., on line 4-5 of Parcel B, on a tangent, along the 80 ft. easterly right-of-way of U.S. Highway No. 101.
