CHAINS

Thence on line 3-1 of Parcel D, identical with a portion of Line 3-2 of Parcel C, along the high water line on W. shore of Tahkenitch Lake.

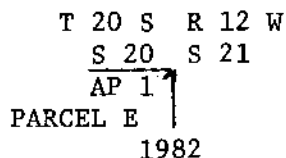

At end of course, Angle Point No. 1 of Parcel D, identical with Angle Point No. 2 of Parcel C, and point of beginning.

Survey of Parcel E in Section 20,
T. 20 S., R. 12 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

Beginning at a point on the line bet. secs. 20 and 21, which bears S. 0° 34' E., 11.82 chs. distant from the cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20, and 21, and described as the point of beginning in the Warranty Deed, dated August 23, 1974, conveying from Willard and Dorothy Haney to the United States of America the following described tract of land in sec. 20, hereinafter identified as Parcel E.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



from which

A cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 57 1/2° W., 20 1/2 lks. dist., mkd. AP1 PAR E BT.

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 51° W., 36 1/2 lks. dist., mkd. AP S20 BT.

Set a steel fence post alongside iron post.

Thence West, on line 1-2 of Parcel E.

Ascend over E. slope, through moderate timber and dense undergrowth.

3.10 Top of ascent, slopes N.; desc. over NW. slope.

7.40 Point for Angle Point No. 1 of Parcel F, hereinafter described.

Descend over NW. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.
