Dependent Resurvey, Portion of N. Bdy.,  
T. 21 S., R. 12 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

**CHAINS**

Timber, fir, spruce, alder, hemlock, and cedar; undergrowth, salal, salmonberry, huckleberry, fern, and young timber.

West, bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Descend 10 ft. over gentle W. slope, through moderate timber and undergrowth.

0.25 Draw, drains N. 50° W.; asc. 45 ft. over NE. slope.

3.40 Ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 55 ft. over W. slope.

5.40 East edge of pond, bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W.

6.40 West edge of pond, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W.; asc. 115 ft. over broken E. slope changing to SE. slope.

9.75 Ridge, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W., also leave timber, edge bears same; desc. 120 ft. over rolling sand dunes.

37.00 Point for the meander cor. of secs. 6 and 31, on the shore of the Pacific Ocean, at record distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an aluminum post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, in concrete, with aluminum post mkd.

Set a steel fence post alongside aluminum post.

The corner is located 3.65 chs. East of mean high tide and shore of the Pacific Ocean, which bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W.

Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, spruce, and dwarf pine; undergrowth, salal, salmonberry, huckleberry, blackberry, grass, and young timber.
