CHAINS

The corner is located at base of sandstone cliff, 75 ft. high, bears N. 60° E. and S. 60° W., on right bank of the Umpqua River.

Thence across river.

29.60

True point for the meander cor. of secs. 16 and 17, on the right bank of the Umpqua River, at record distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. This point falls in the river, and is impossible to monument.

Land, rolling to mountainous.

Soil, clay sandy loam.

Timber, spruce, hemlock, fir, cedar, and alder; undergrowth, salal, salmonberry, thimbleberry, huckleberry, blackberry, marsh grass, and fern.

From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9, perpetuated and recorded by W.G. Corbitt, for Crown Zellerbach Corporation, in 1943, monumented with an iron pipe, 1 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, flush with the surface of the ground, from which the remains of an original bearing tree:

A decayed spruce stump, 57 ins. diam., bears S. 81° E., 25 1/2 lks. dist., with scribe mark S visible on open blaze. (Record and to face, 22 lks.)

At the corner point

Set an aluminum post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, directly over the iron pipe, with aluminum cap mkd.

A spruce, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 81° E., 27 lks. dist., mkd. T21S R12W S4 BT.

A spruce, 26 ins. diam., bears S. 21° E., 38 lks. dist., mkd. T21S R12W S9 BT.

A spruce, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 37 1/4° W., 66 lks. dist., mkd. T21S R12W S8 BT.

A spruce, 25 ins. diam., bears N. 46° W., 15 lks. dist., mkd. T21S R12W S5 BT.

N. 4° 09' W., bet. secs. 4 and 5.

Ascend 260 ft. over broken SW. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.

Ridge, bears N. 40° W. and S. 40° E.; also U.S. Highway No. 101, asphalt surfaced, 70 lks. wide, bears same; continue over nearly level ridge top.

Leave ridge; desc. 105 ft. over steep N. slope.

Draw, drains NE.; asc. 5 ft. over SE. slope.
