CHAINS

The following field notes are those of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the south and west boundaries, subdivisional lines, and subdivision of section 31, Township 29 South, Range 6 West, Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

The history of surveys pertaining to this resurvey is as follows:

The south and west boundaries of the township and a portion of the subdivisional lines were surveyed by Nathaniel Ford in 1854.

The subdivisional lines of Township 30 South, Range 6 West, were surveyed by Addison R. Flint in 1855.

A portion of the south and west boundaries and subdivisional lines was retraced and the subdivisional lines were completed by Fred Mensch in 1905.

The west boundary of section 31 was retraced by Roy T. Campbell in 1910.

A portion of the south boundary of the township and subdivisional lines was dependently resurveyed by Hans W. Thielsen and C. Albert White in 1958-59.

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A portion of the south boundary was dependently resurveyed by James E. Jelley and Wayne L. Rogers in 1980.

The survey was executed in accordance with specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, and the Special Instructions for Group No. 1030, Oregon, dated August 4, 1980.

The directions of the lines were determined by deflections from azimuths obtained by direct solar observations.

Preliminary to the resurvey the lines of the survey were retraced and search was made for all corners and other calls of the record. Identified corners were remonumented in their original positions. Lost corners were reestablished and remonumented at proportionate positions based on the official record. The retracement data were thoroughly verified and only the true line field notes are given herein. The lines not forming a closure were measured twice to preclude error. Only lines bounding or crossing public lands were blazed.

The geographic position of the closing corner of sections 31 and 32, as scaled from the United States Geological Survey quadrangle map, "CANYONVILLE, OREGON", prepared in 1954, is as follows:

Latitude 42° 59.9' N. Longitude 123° 26.5' W.

The mean magnetic declination is 19° 00' E.

** The south one-half mile between sections 31 and 36 on the west boundary of the township, was dependently resurveyed by Lynn M. Roseberry in 1968.
