CHAINS

Access to the area is gained by numerous gravelled and dirt logging roads.

Timber in the area consists of fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, ash, maple, madrone, oak, alder, and chinquapin, with undergrowth of salal, Oregon grape, hazel, arrowwood, fern, poison oak, blackberry, salmonberry, wildrose, manzanita, and young timber. The soil is composed of rocky clay, with scattered rock outcrops. There are numerous unpatented mineral claims scattered throughout section 31.

The average of a number of readings over the area gives a value of $19^{\circ} 00'$ E., for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of $1/2^{\circ}$ in local attraction.
