	GENERAL DESCRIPTION The lands included in the foregoing resurvey are located in mountainous country about 4 miles north of Drain, Oregon. The elevation ranges from about 440 feet above sea level at the 1/4 section corner of sections 33 and 34 to about 1,200 feet above sea level near the west 1/16 section corner of sections 28 and 33. The area is drained by Fitch Creek to the southwest, Ellenburg Creek to the northeast, and numerous other small drainages. The soil consists of a sandy loam in the main creek bottoms to rocky clay in the higher elevations. The lands are forested with fir, yew, oak,
