madrone, pine, ash, alder, maple, and chinquapin. Undergrowth consists of poison oak, fern, arrowwood, hazel, Oregon grape, salal, blackberry, salmonberry, thimbleberry, huckleberry, wild rose, rhododendron, and young timber.

Access is gained by asphalt surfaced State Highway No. 38 and Smith River Road, with numerous other gravelled and dirt access roads.

There were no mineral deposits noted along the lines resurveyed.

The average of a number of readings throughout the area gives a value of 20° 15' E. for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of 1° due to local attraction.
