## CHAINS

The following field notes are those of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the east boundary, Township 24 South, Range 2 West, and a portion of the subdivisional lines, and subdivision of section 20, Township 24 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

The history of surveys pertaining to this resurvey is as follows:

The east boundary of Township 24 South, Range 2 West, was surveyed by John A. McQuinn, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1883.

The east boundary of Township 24 South, Range 2 West, was resurveyed and the subdivisional lines of Township 24 South, Range 1 West, were surveyed by Winfield S. Chapman and Carl S. Nicklin, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1896.

A portion of the east boundary of Township 24 South, Range 2 West, was resurveyed by Lynn M. Roseberry, Cadastral Surveyor, in 1967.

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, the Special Instructions dated March 6, 1981, and the Supplemental Special Instructions dated October 28, 1981, for Group No. 1051, Oregon.

The directions of the lines were determined by deflections from azimuths obtained by direct solar observations and refer to the true meridian.

Preliminary to the resurvey, the lines of the original survey were retraced and search was made for all corners and other calls of the record. Identified corners were remonumented in their original positions. Lost corners were reestablished and remonumented at proportionate positions based on the official record. The retracement data were thoroughly verified and only the true line field notes are given herein. Only those lines bounding or crossing public lands were blazed. All lines not forming a closure were measured twice to preclude error.

The geographic position of the corner of sections 20, 21, 28, and 29, as scaled from the MACE MIN., OREG., 15 minute series, topographic map, prepared by the United States Geological Survey, in 1955., is as follows:

Latitude 43° 28.0' N. Longitude 122° 49.1' W.

The mean magnetic declination is 19° 30' E.
