A yew, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 56° E., 20 lks. dist., mkd. X BT.

N. 0° 09' W., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 360 ft. over SE. slope, changing to SW. slope.

9.00 Gravelled road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 40° E. and S. 45° W.

16.60 Spur, slopes S. 60° W.; desc. 60 ft. over NW. slope.

A root hole, bears S. 37 1/2° E., 27 1/2 lks. dist., with down cedar alongside, 8 ins. diam., with scribe marks S20 C 1/4 BT visible on partially healed blaze.

A burned fir stump, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 61° W., 19 lks. dist.; no marks visible.

and a new bearing tree and reference monument

A sawed fir stump, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 20° W., 22 1/2 lks. dist., mkd. C 1/4 S20 BT.

An aluminum post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., set 24 ins. in ground, for a reference monument, bears S. 45° E., 15 lks. dist., with aluminum cap mkd. RM C1/4 S20 1982, with an arrow pointing to the cor.

N. 0° 03' W., beginning new measurement.

Descend 235 ft. over NW. slope.

31.20 Ravine, drains N. 70° W.; asc. 210 ft. over SW. slope.
