<p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The lands included in the foregoing resurvey are located in mountainous country about 17 miles north-easterly from Glide, Oregon. Access into the area is gained by way of an asphalt surfaced road along Rock Creek, and a number of gravelled and dirt road extending into the area.</p> <p>The area is drained by Rock Creek and its tributaries. The elevations range from about 1,750 feet above sea level near the corner of sections 19 and 30 only, to about 3,750 feet above sea level near the S 1/16 section corner of sections 20 and 21.</p>
