CHAINS

The soil consists of a rocky clay. The timber consists of fir, yew, hemlock, cedar, maple, madrone, chinquapin, oak, and alder. Undergrowth is mainly hazel, arrowwood, vine maple, Oregon grape, salal, rhododendron, fern, blackberry, manzanita, and young timber.

There were no mineral deposits noted along the lines resurveyed.

The average of a considerable number of readings throughout the area gives a value of $19^{\circ} 30'$ E. for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of 1° due to local attraction.
