Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky clay.
Timber, fir, cedar, oak, hemlock, yew, chinquapin, maple, walnut, alder, madrone, ash, and cottonwood; undergrowth, poison oak, arrowwood, hazel, salal, Oregon grape, salmonberry, blackberry, huckleberry, wild rose, fern, rhododendron, vine maple, and young timber.

From the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 14 and 23, monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 2 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

19.70 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S. 40° E.; asc. over NE. slope.
