CHAINS

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N. 76° E., 83 lks. dist., with healed blaze. (Record, N. 64° E., 95 lks. dist. Slope distance is 95 lks.)

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 89 1/2° E., 92 lks. dist., with healed blaze. (Record, N. 83 1/2° E., 105 lks. dist. Slope distance is 105 lks.)

From this point, the point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 36 only, on the E. bdy. of T. 33 S., R. 8 W., bears S. 0° 06' E., 0.20 chs. dist., determined at record bearing and distance from the remaining original bearing tree

A fir, 45 ins. diam., bears N. 9° W., 47 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

No permanent monument set.

N. 0° 29' W., on the W. bdy. of sec. 31.

Along steep, rocky, broken E. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

39.15 Abandoned dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. and S. 20° W.; thence along road.

40.01 The cor. of secs. 25 and 36 only, on the E. bdy. of T. 33 S., R. 8 W., perpetuated by person(s) unknown, monumented with an iron pipe, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 10 ins. above ground, and in a mound of stone, 2 1/2 ft. base, to top, from which the remains of the original bearing trees

A sawed fir stump, 38 ins. diam., bears S. 68° W., 98 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on opened blaze.

A sawed fir stump, 32 ins. diam., bears N. 38° W., 106 lks. dist., with scribe marks BT visible on opened blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, directly over the iron pipe, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
