A tanoak, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 15° W., 61 lks. dist., mkd. T33S R8W S25 BT.

Descend 5 ft. along abandoned road.

The cor. of secs. 30 and 31 only, perpetuated and recorded by Ronald A. Brandt, Registered Land Surveyor, No. 841, in 1981, monumented with an iron pipe, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 2 ins. above ground, from which the remains of the bearing trees mkd. by Price and Shaffner

A root hole, bears N. 60° E., 142 lks. dist., alongside of which is lying a decayed ponderosa pine, 30 ins. diam., with illegible scribe marks visible on opened blaze. (Record, 170 lks. dist. slope distance is 170 lks.)

A fir, 41 ins. diam., bears S. 28° E., 115 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

and bearing trees mkd. by Brandt

A madrone, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 41° E., 44 1/2 lks. dist., with scribe marks S30 PS 841 BT visible on open blaze.

A tanoak, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 35° E., 53 1/2 lks. dist., with scribe marks S31 PS 841 BT visible on open blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, directly over the iron pipe, and in a mound of stone, 2 1/2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

From the cor. of secs. 18 and 19 only, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with the original granite stone, 30 x 8 x 5 ins., loosely set, 8 ins. in the ground, with 3 faint grooves visible on the S. side, from which the original bearing trees

A maple, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 69° E., 65 lks. dist., with healed double blaze. (Record, 67 lks.)

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 11° E., 27 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 17° W., 35 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.
