CHAINS

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 46° E., 8 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on partially healed blaze.

The corner is located in SW. corner of logged area.

From the center N 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 35.

N. 89° 50' W., on the E. and W. center line of the NW 1/4 of sec. 35.

Ascend 290 ft. over broken SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

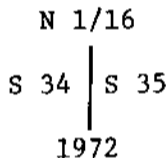
0.30 Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 10° E. and S. 25° W.

12.40 Spur, slopes S. 25° E.; desc. 225 ft. over NW. slope.

20.98 The NW 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 35.

Descend 605 ft. over NW. slope.

41.90 The N 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 34 and 35, monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir stump, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 20° E., 19 lks. dist., with scribe marks N 1/16 S35 BT visible on open blaze. (Record, S. 17° E.)

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 39 1/2° W., 15 lks. dist., with healed blaze. (Record, S. 43° W.)

and a new bearing tree

A cedar, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 77 1/2° E., 12 1/2 lks. dist., mkd. N 1/16 S35 BT.

From this point the Douglas County Surveyor's Office, horizontal control station, SNAKE 1972, bears S. 78° 41' W., 11.41 chs. dist., monumented with a brass tablet, 2 1/2 ins. diam., set in bedrock, with top mkd. Douglas County Surveyors Office SNAKE · 1972.

DESCRIPTION

The lands included in the foregoing resurvey are located in mountainous country about five miles south-easterly of Glide, Oregon. The elevation ranges from 880 feet above sea level at the corner of sections 2, 3, 34, and 35 to about 3,040 feet above sea level near the 1/4 section corner of sections 25 and 36.

The area is drained by Rattlesnake Creek and Engles Creek, with numerous other small drainages which all flow into Little River. The soil consists of a rocky clay, The lands are forested with fir, pine, cedar, hemlock,
