	Descend over broken W. slope.
3.10	Enter timber, edge bears N. and S.
19.00	Left bank of Smith River, bears N. 14° E. and S. 14° W., course S. 14° W.; Thence across river.
20.05	Right bank of Smith River, bears same; asc. over broken E. slope.
21.18	Smith River Road, asphalt surface, 30 lks. wide, bears N. and S. 14° W., in a curve.
21.945	The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 27 and 34, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., with a brass cap, firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above ground, alongside of which is a steel fence post, firmly set, projecting 4 ft. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

	from which the remaining bearing tree mkd. by Tillman and Gawron
	A fir, 56 ins. diam., bears S. 59° W., 110 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.

	An alder, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 18° E., 21 lks. dist., with scribe marks S27 BT visible on a bark blaze.

	S. 89° 55' W., beginning new measurement.
	Ascend over E. slope, through moderate timber and dense undergrowth.
6.30	Spur ridge, bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W.; desc. over broken W. slope.
25.00	Smith River Road, asphalt surface, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.
27.10	Right bank of Smith River, bears N. 10° E., and S. 10° W., course N. 10° E.; thence across river.
28.50	Left bank of Smith River, bears same; asc. over broken E. slope.
40.38	The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33, and 34, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

	from which the remaining original bearing tree
	A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N. 17 3/4° W., 49 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.
