Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, and alder; undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, huckleberry, rhododendron, salmonberry, arrowwood, salal, and fern.</p>
	<p>N. 0° 56' W., bet. secs. 27 and 28.</p> <p>Ascend over broken E. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.</p>
