CHAINS

The timber is moderate to dense, consisting of fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, and maple. The undergrowth is light to heavy consisting of vine maple, salal, huckleberry, salmonberry, arrowwood, Oregon grape, and fern.

The principal use of the area is timber production.

There was no evidence of mineral deposits noted on the lines surveyed.

The mean of a considerable number of observations of the magnetic declination throughout the township is 21° E., with a range of 2° in local attraction.
