A cedar, 46 ins. diam., bears N. 31° E., 23 lks. dist., rescribed by King, with scribe marks 1/4 S22 BT visible on bark blaze. (Record, N. 25° E., 19 lks.)

A cedar, 37 ins. diam., bears S. 24° W., 34 lks. dist., with scribe marks 1/4 S visible on bark blaze, rescribed by King, with scribe marks 1/4 S BT visible on bark blaze. (Record, S. 35° W.)

and the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Powell

A pine, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 71° E., 51 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A fir snag, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 73° W., 28 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on partially healed blaze.

and a new bearing tree

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 59 1/4° W., 55 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S21 BT.

N. 0° 44' E., bet. secs. 21 and 22, marking and blazing the true line.

Ascend SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

5.30 Power transmission line, bears N. 50° E. and S. 50° W.

20.35 Spur, slopes S. 60° E.; desc. NE. slope.

30.40 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course S. 35° E.; asc. SW. slope.

40.32 The cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21, and 22, perpetuated and recorded by Victor S. King, Registered Land Surveyor No. 442, in 1960, monumented with the original basalt stone, 14 x 10 x 8 ins., firmly set, projecting 5 ins. above a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1 ft. high, marked with 3 grooves on S. and E. faces, from which the remains of the original bearing trees

A cedar snag, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 61° E., 32 lks. dist., no marks visible.

A fir root crown, size indeterminate, bears S. 66° E., 21 lks. dist., no marks visible.

and bearing trees mkd. by King

A madrone, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 33° E., 40 1/2 lks. dist., with scribe marks T31S R5W S15 BT visible on partially healed blaze.

A madrone, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 53° E., 12 1/2 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.
