CHAINS

and a new bearing tree

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 21 1/2° W.,  
11 1/2 lks. dist., mkd. T31S R5W S30 BT.

The corner is located 50 lks. north of a gravelled road,  
25 lks. wide, bears E. and W.

From this same point, the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25, and  
30, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., bears S. 87° 53' W.,  
84.67 chs. dist., perpetuated and recorded by Bruce A.  
Shaner, Registered Land Surveyor No. 430, in 1964,  
further perpetuated and recorded by John M. Powell,  
Deputy County Surveyor, in 1966, monumented with an iron  
post, 1 1/4 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 10 ins.  
above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A sawed fir stump, 48 ins. diam., bears  
N. 62° W., 71 lks. dist., with scribe marks  
S24 visible on open blaze.

and bearing trees mkd. by Shaner

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 47 3/4° E.,  
86 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks  
visible on partially healed blaze.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 21 1/4° E.,  
58 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 47 ins. diam., bears S. 47° W.,  
93 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks  
visible on partially healed blaze.

and a new bearing tree

A grand fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 84° W.,  
54 lks. dist., mkd. X BT.

The corner is located 50 lks. south of a gravelled road,  
25 lks. wide, bears N. 65° W. and S. 80° E.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, cedar, oak, yew, madrone, hemlock, maple,  
alder, ash, and chinquapin; undergrowth, poison oak,  
salal, Oregon grape, arrowwood, blackberry, salmonberry,  
huckleberry, thimbleberry, hazel, ferns, wild rose, and  
young timber.

N. 1° 11' E., bet. secs. 19 and 20.

Ascend broken SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense  
undergrowth.
