A fir snag, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 20 3/4° W.,  
158 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks  
visible on partially healed blaze. (Record,  
S. 19 3/4° W.)

and bearing trees mkd. by Godfrey

A fir, 23 ins. diam., bears N. 80° E., 113 lks.  
dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 19 ins. diam., bears S. 37° W., 119 lks.  
dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 20 3/4° W., 71  
lks. dist., with healed blaze.

and an unrecorded bearing tree

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 18 3/4° E., 59 1/2  
lks. dist., with healed blaze.

and new bearing trees

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 35 3/4° E., 45 lks.  
dist., mkd. T25S R4W S20 BT.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 29 1/2° W., 35 1/2 lks.  
dist., mkd. T25S R4W S30 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, yew, pine, alder, maple,  
ash, madrone, oak, chinquapin, and cottonwood; under-  
growth, Oregon grape, vine maple, poison oak, blackberry,  
salmonberry, thimbleberry, huckleberry, salal, arrowwood,  
hazel, fern, and young timber.

From the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 20 and 29, monumented with  
an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 3 ins.  
above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A sawed fir stump, 52 ins. diam., bears N. 69° E.,  
8 lks. dist., no marks visible. (Record, 5 lks.)

and a bearing tree recorded in 1957

A sawed fir stump, 22 ins. diam., bears S. 85° W.,  
40 1/2 lks. dist., with scribe marks BT visible on  
opened blaze.

and the remains of a bearing tree mkd. in 1957

A root hole, bears S. 85 1/4° W., 139 lks. dist., with  
an uprooted fir alongside, 22 ins. diam., no marks  
visible.

and new bearing trees

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 75° W., 109 lks.  
dist., mkd. 1/4 S20 BT.
