CHAINS

76.00 Small draw, drains N. 60° W.; asc. 25 ft. over SW. slope.

78.35 Small spur, slopes N. 60° W.; desc. 5 ft. over NW. slope.

79.03 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33, and 34, which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 9 ins. above ground, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

Land, mountainous.
Soil, sandy clay; 2nd and 3rd rate.
Timber, fir, cedar, pine, yew, and hemlock.
Undergrowth, vinemapple, rhododendron, hazel, Oregon grape, and bracken.

Portion of North Boundary of T. 31 S., R. 1 E.

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33, and 34, on N. bdy. of Tp. East, bet. secs. 3 and 34.

Asc. 550 ft. over W. slope, through heavy timber and light undergrowth.

6.00 Enter fir reproduction, bears N. and S.

20.00 Leave fir reproduction, bears N. and S.

25.50 Spur, slopes N. 15° W.; desc. 285 ft. over NE. slope.

39.70 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course N. 10° W.; asc. 7 ft. over NW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34, and 35, with brass cap mkd.
