## General Description.

and suitable only for poles, piling, and rough lumber.

There are no apparent indications of mineral deposits nor has there been any diligent prospecting.

The south portion of the township is drained by the tributaries of the Rogue River and the north portion by the tributaries of the South Umpqua River. A Forest Service Road and Telephone line follow the divide through secs. 10, 11, 12, and 1. The location of the road and telephone line are ascertained by notation of the intersections on the section boundaries. Butler Butte Lookout is located in the east central portion of section 10.

The magnetic variation in this township has a range from 19° E. to 23° E.; the mean of numerous observations is 21° E.
