A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 14° E., 44 lks.  
dist., mkd. 1/4 S5 BT.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 56 1/2° W., 20 lks.  
dist., mkd. 1/4 S6 BT.

From this point, a point established and recorded by  
Wilford N. Haines, Registered Land Surveyor, No. 239, in  
1960, and perpetuated and recorded by Gary Langlitz,  
Deputy County Surveyor, in 1974, bears N. 30° 30' E.,  
0.175 chs. dist., monumented with a "T" shaped iron rod,  
1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above ground,  
with steel washer mkd. Wilford N. Haines. 239 Survey  
Point Drain Oregon, with an iron pipe alongside, 1 1/4 ins.  
diam., firmly set, projecting 10 ins. above ground, with  
brass cap sawed off, from which the remains of a bearing  
tree recorded by Haines

A root hole, bears S. 85° E., 15 lks. dist.,  
with a down fir alongside, 18 ins. diam.,  
with fragmentary scribe marks visible on  
opened blaze.

A root hole, bears S. 50° W., 15 lks. dist.,  
with a down fir alongside, 18 ins. diam.,  
with healed blaze.

and bearing trees mkd. by Langlitz

A cedar, 19 ins. diam., bears S. 45° W.,  
84 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 17 ins. diam., bears N. 31° W.,  
114 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

The corner is located on spur, slopes N. 50° W.

Descend over NW. slope.

52.75 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course S. 60° W.; asc. over broken  
SE. slope.

67.30 Ridge, bears N. 60° E. and S. 80° W.; desc. over  
NW. slope, also gravelled road, 25 lks. wide, bears  
N. 60° E. and S. 80° W.
