65.8 FT TO COR 1983 and an arrow pointing to
the cor.

A black oak, 32 ins. diam., bears S. $38\frac{3}{4}^\circ$ W.,
289 lks. dist., mkd. T28S R7W S9 BT.

Deposit the $\frac{3}{4}$ in. iron pipe alongside the iron post.

From this point, the Douglas County Surveyor's Horizontal
Control Station, "LOOK", bears S. $63^\circ 31'E.$, 70.09 chs.
dist., monumented with a brass tablet, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set
in concrete, with top mkd. DOUGLAS COUNTY SURVEYORS
OFFICE LOOK 1977.
