## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The portion of the township covered by this resurvey, lies in Douglas County about 7 1/2 miles southeast of the city of Sutherlin, Oregon. The northern portion of the township is drained by Calapooya Creek which flows in a westerly direction through the township, with numerous other small drainages flowing into Calapooya Creek. The main access into the area is by way of an asphalt surfaced road along Calapooya Creek and a number of gravelled and dirt roads extending from it into the area. Elevations range from about 890 feet above sea level at the corner of sections 21, 22, 27, and 28 to about 1,720 feet above sea level near the center 1/4 section corner of section 27.

Timber consists of fir, hemlock, cedar, oak, madrone, maple, and alder. The undergrowth consists of fern, blackberry, poison oak, salal, arrowwood, hazel, vine maple, Oregon grape, and young timber. Portions of the area have been logged. The area is mainly used for timber and recreation.

The soil is rocky clay. There were no mineral deposits noted along the lines resurveyed.

The average of a considerable number of readings over all parts of the area gives a value of 19° 00' E. for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of 1° 30' in local attraction.
