CHAINS

The following field notes are those of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, and subdivision of section 2, Township 21 South, Range 8 West, Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

The history of surveys pertaining to this resurvey is as follows:

The north boundary and subdivisional lines were surveyed by William P. Wright, Deputy Surveyor, in 1883.

The north boundary of the township was resurveyed by Thomas A. Tillman, Cadastral Surveyor, in 1950.

A portion of the subdivisional lines was resurveyed by Marvin J. Lytle, Palmer Norseth, Thomas A. Tillman, Raymond M. Bicknell, Joseph S. Gawron, and Hans W. Thielsen, Cadastral Engineers, in 1952-54.

Certain original corner points on the north boundary and subdivisional lines were remonumented without survey by William W. Glenn, C. Albert White, and James E. Jelley, Cadastral Surveyors, in 1967.

The survey and resurvey were executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, and Special Instructions, dated July 27, 1983, under Group No. 1171, Oregon.

The directions of the lines refer to the true meridian as determined by deflection angles turned from azimuths obtained by direct solar observations.

Preliminary to the resurvey, the line of the original survey was retraced and search was made for all corners and other calls of the record. The retracement data were thoroughly verified and only the true line field notes are given herein. All lines were blazed. All lines not forming a closure were measured twice to preclude error.

The geographic position of the 1/4 section corner of sections 1 and 2, as determined by a tie to triangulation station "VINCENT", established by the United States Geological Survey in 1940, is as follows:

Latitude 43° 46' 10.5" N. Longitude 123° 36' 04.2" W.

The mean magnetic declination is 19° 45'E
