## CHAINS

Soil in the area is composed of a rocky clay loam from a few inches to several feet in depth overlying sandstone bedrock. The lands are forested with fir, cedar, hemlock, madrone, alder, and maple. The undergrowth consists of young timber, salmonberry, huckleberry, vine maple, salal, Oregon grape, ferns, and grasses.

There is an abandoned rock quarry south of the corner of sections 2, 3, 10, and 11, just north of Smith River Road.

The average of a considerable number of readings throughout the area gives a value of  $19^{\circ} 45'$  E. for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of up to  $0^{\circ} 45'$  due to local attraction.
