CHAINS

The area is drained to the northeast by Sleezer Creek, Alder Creek, and numerous other seasonal drainages which flow into the Smith River. The lands are forested by stands of old growth fir, hemlock, oak, maple, madrone, cedar, and ash. Undergrowth consists of vine maple, salal, arrowwood, fern, and poison oak. The soil is rocky clay loam.

Access is gained by way of paved Smith River Road and other gravelled and dirt roads which extend from it.

There were no mineral deposits noted along the line resurveyed.

The average of a number of readings throughout the area gives a value of $19 \frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ East for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of 1° due to local attraction.
