A white fir, 22 ins. diam., bears n.  $58\frac{1}{4}^\circ$  E.,  
35 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A fir stump, 8 ins. diam., bears S.  $25^\circ$  E.,  
27  $\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., with downed tree alongside,  
fragmentary scribe marks visible on partially  
healed blaze.

A white fir stump, 8 ins. diam., bears  
S.  $25\frac{1}{2}^\circ$  W., 25  $\frac{1}{2}$  lks, dist., with  
downed tree alongside.

A white fir snag, 11 ins. diam., bears  
N.  $23\frac{1}{2}^\circ$  W., 29 lks. dist., with fragmentary  
scribe marks visible on partially healed blaze.

and new bearing trees

A white fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.  $57\frac{1}{2}^\circ$  E.,  
43 lks. dist., mkd. T30S R 7W S27 BT.

A white fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.  $10\frac{1}{2}^\circ$  W.,  
105 lks. dist., mkd. T30S R7W S28 BT.

A white fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.  $59^\circ$  W.,  
161 lks. dist., mkd. T30S R7W S21 BT.

S.  $89^\circ 36'$  W., bet. secs. 21 and 28, marking and  
blazing the true line.

Ascend over NE. slope, through scattering timber and  
dense undergrowth.

10.50 Spur, slopes N.  $20^\circ$  E.; desc. over NW. slope.

16.25 Gravelled road, 25 lks. wide, bears N.  $70^\circ$  E. and  
S.  $70^\circ$  W.

18.50 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N.  $60^\circ$  E.; asc. over SE.  
slope.

19.79 True point for the E  $\frac{1}{16}$  sec. cor. of secs. 21 and 28,  
at proportionate distance.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24  
ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

106 lks. dist., mkd. E  $\frac{1}{16}$  S 21 BT.

A hemlock, 20 ins. diam., bears S.  $50^\circ$  W.,  
51  $\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., mkd. E  $\frac{1}{16}$  S28 BT.

Descend slightly along N. bank of creek, 5 lks. wide,  
course E.
