GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The portion of the township covered by this survey lies in Douglas County about eight miles west of the town of Riddle, Oregon. The main drainage for the township is Cow Creek which flows in a northeasterly direction through the southern part of the township. There are also numerous other small drainages flowing into Cow Creek. The elevations range from about 1,660 feet above sea level near the E 1/16 section corner of sections 21 and 28, to about 2,160 feet above sea level near the 1/4 section corner of sections 20 and 21.

Access is by way of paved Cow Creek Road and by numerous other gravelled roads leading into the area.

Timber in the area consists of fir, hemlock, cedar, pine oak, maple, alder, and yew; undergrowth consists of salal, fern, manzanita, poison oak, and arrowwood.

The soil consists of rocky clay loam. There were no mineral deposits noted on any of the lines resurveyed.
