**CHAINS**

From this point, a corner established and recorded by George J. Wenderoth, Registered Land Surveyor, No. 5, in 1950-51, bears N. 45° 00' E., 0.025 chs. dist., monumented with an iron rod, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above ground, from which the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Wenderoth

A fir snag, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 51° E., 11 lks. dist., with scribe marks S B visible on open blaze.

A root hole, bears S. 42° E., 10 lks. dist., with down fir alongside, 12 ins. diam., no marks visible.

Ascend over broken SE. slope.

Barbed wire fence, extends N. 35° E. and S. 35° W.

Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 65° E. and S. 65° W.

Spur, slopes S. 40° E.; asc. over SE. slope, also dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.

Barbed wire fence, extends N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.

The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 18 and 19.

From the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 20.

S. 86° 55' W., on the E. and W. center line of sec. 19.

Descend over broken NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

Point for the center E 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 19.

Set an aluminum post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 62° E., 4 lks. dist., mkd. CE 1/16 S19 BT.

From this point, a corner established and recorded by George J. Wenderoth, Registered Land Surveyor, No. 5, in 1950-51, bears S. 64° 53' E., 0.141 chs. dist., monumented with an angle iron, 1 1/2 x 1/4 ins., firmly set, projecting 10 ins. above ground, from which the remains of a bearing tree mkd. by Wenderoth

A fir snag, 38 ins. diam., bears S. 13° W., 25 lks. dist., no marks visible.

Descend over broken NW. slope.
