CHAINS

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 30° E., 28 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

and a bearing tree mkd. by Wenderoth

A cedar, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 72° E., 142 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

and bearing trees mkd. by the County Surveyor's Office

The north fork of a twin cedar, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 57½° E., 130½ lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A cedar, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 80 3/4° W., 316 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

No other suitable trees available within limits.

Corner is located 11 lks. east and approximately 2 ft. lower in elevation from the east edge of Quines Creek Road, asphalt surfaced, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 40° W., and S., in curve.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rock clay.

Timber, pine, fir, cedar, oak, maple, dogwood, and madrone; undergrowth, poison oak, ceanothus, Oregon grape, manzanita, salal, grass, and weeds.

N. 0° 19' E., bet. secs. 22 and 23.

Descend along gentle E. slope, through scattering timber and light undergrowth.

4.25 Quines Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 20° W.; asc. along nearly level W. slope, through meadow with scattering timber.

19.95 Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears E. and W.

20.35 Enter heavy timber, edge bears E. and W.

25.20 Top of ascent, slopes W.; desc. over NW. slope.

29.75 Leave timber, enter open pasture, edge bears NE. and SW.

40.30 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 22 and 23, reestablished by proportionate measurement and recorded by George J. Wenderoth, Registered Land Surveyor, No. 5, in 1953, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner, monumented with an automobile axle, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 2 ins. above ground, from which bearing trees mkd. by Wenderoth:

A cottonwood, 31 ins. diam., bears S. 82° E., 175 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A white oak, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 63° W., 70½ lks. dist., with healed blaze.
