CHAINS

The timber is mostly pine, fir, cedar, oak, maple, dogwood, madrone, ash, alder, and cottonwood. The undergrowth is primarily poison oak, ceanothus, Oregon grape, manzanita, salal, grass, and weeds.

There was no known mineral deposits noted along the lines surveyed.

The magnetic declination for the area surveyed is 20° E., as shown on the Canyonville, Oregon, 15 minute quadrangle, dated 1954.
