AFFIDAVIT

To whom it may concern: I, Donald W. Brady, do hereby state that I have been a resident of the area adjacent to the corner of sections 13, 14, 23 and 24, and the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner of sections 14 and 23, T. 32 S., R. 5 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, since 1921, and that I have had definite knowledge of the location of these corners for many years.

I helped George Wenderoth, ORLS No. 5, survey the subdivision of section 23, T. 32 W., R. 5W., in 1953. He established the corner of sections 13, 14, 23, and 24 from a vine maple with scribe marks. He established the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of sections 14 and 23 from a harrow tooth he found in the center of a dirt road. This harrow tooth has existed since I moved to this area as a child in 1921, and was always used as the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner of sections 14 and 23 by the adjacent landowners.
