

# County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

**CHAINS**

Preliminary to the resurvey, the lines of the original survey were retraced and search was made for all corners and other calls of the record. Identified corners were remonumented in their original positions, lost corners were reestablished at proportionate positions, based on the official record. The retrace-ment data were thoroughly verified, and only the true line field notes are given herein. All lines not forming closures were chained twice to preclude error. Only those lines bounding, or crossing public lands were blazed.

The geographic position of the closing corner of Township 21 South, Range 10 West and Township 22 South, Range 9 West, as determined from a tie to United States Coast and Geodetic Survey Triangulation Station "FERN TOP 1953", is as follows:

Latitude 43° 41' 35.8" N. Longitude 123° 49' 34.6"W.

The mean magnetic declination is 18° 45' E.
