Point for the S 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 27 and 28.

From this point the S 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 27 and 28, erroneously established by Wofford, Rogers, and Chatters, in 1973-79, bears N. 72° 26' E., 0.04 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

Remove the iron post, and at the true corner point

Reset the iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A sawed fir stump, 48 ins. diam., bears
S. 30° E., 26 lks. dist., with illegible
scribe marks visible on opened blaze.

A sawed fir stump, 38 ins. diam., bears
N. 49° W., 100 lks. dist., with illegible
scribe marks visible on open blaze.

Ascend over broken N. slope.
