26.00	Spur, slopes N. 40° E.; desc. over N. slope.
34.70	Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. 75° E.; asc. over S. slope.
36.40	Top of ascent, slopes NE.; desc. along E. slope
38.33	The cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28.

38.70	Ravine, drains S. 30° W.; desc. over SW. slope.
