## CHAINS

area southeasterly of Scottsburg is drained by numerous small creeks flowing northerly to the Umpqua River. The soil being of rocky clay loam, supports a bountiful growth of timber consisting of fir, cedar, maple, and alder. The dense undergrowth consists of salmonberry, blackberry, vine maple, ferns, arrowwood, and poison oak.

There were no mineral deposits or mining activity noted along the lines of the survey.

The mean of the considerable number of observations of the magnetic declination throughout the township is  $18^{\circ} 45'$  E., with a range of  $1^{\circ}$  due to local attraction.
