**CHAINS**

S. 89° 11' W., on the E. and W. center line of the NW¼ of sec. 11.

Ascend over broken NE. slope.

0.90 Private driveway, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 45° E. and S. 45° W.

1.35 From the point, a woodshed, 10 ft. x 15 ft. bears South, 0.20 chs. dist.

1.95 Fence line bears N. and S.

2.75 From this point, a pumphouse, 8 ft. x 10 ft. bears South, 0.90 chs. dist.

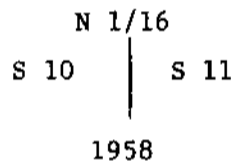
16.80 Spur, slopes N. 20° E.; desc. over broken N. slope.

20.37 The NW 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 11.

Descend over broken N. slope.

30.85 Gravelled road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 15° W. and S. 15° E.

40.79 The N 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 10 and 11, monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 14½° E.,  
67 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 19 ins. diam., bears S. 69° W.,  
255 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

**GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

The portion of Township 27 South, Range 3 West, covered by this resurvey, is located approximately four miles southwest of the town of Glide, Oregon. The area is drained primarily by Little River, Cavitt Creek, and Jim Creek, with a number of other small drainages. The elevations range from about 840 feet above sea level along Little River in the north portion of section 3, to about 2,000 feet above sea level in the southwest portion of section 3.

Access into the area is via Little River Road and Cavitt Creek Road, and a number of gravelled and dirt roads extending from them into the area.

No evidence of minerals were noted in the area covered by this survey.

The average of a considerable number of readings over the entire area gives a value of 20° 00' E., for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of up to 3° in local attraction.
