	From the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 11 and 14. N. 0° 36' W., on the N. and S. center line of sec. 11. Descend over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
1.10	McNabb Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. 30° E.; asc. over SE. slope.
3.60	Spur, slopes N. 70° E.; desc. over NE. slope.
14.45	McNabb Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. 25° W.; continue to desc. along creek bottom.
26.80	Gravelled road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 15° E. and S. 15° E., in a curve.
38.00	Same road, bears NW. and SE.
38.75	Point for the center 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 11, at inter- section with the E. and W. center line. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
