

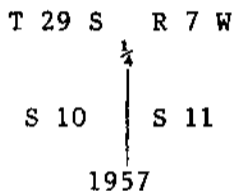

**CHAINS**

- 43.10 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, course N. 35° W. and S. 40° E.
- 43.60 McNabb Creek 1 lk. wide, course N. 20° E.; asc. over broken SE. slope.
- 45.75 Gravelled road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 20° E. and S. 25° W.
- 70.25 Ridge, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W., to saddle; desc. over SW. slope, changing to NW.
- 76.40 Gravelled road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 5° W. and S. 5° W.
- 85.50 The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 10 and 11, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

100 lks. dist., with fragmentary reverse  
scribe marks visible on opened blaze.

A fir, 31 ins. diam., bears S. 49 1/2° E.,  
75 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A fir snag, 11 ins. diam., bears N. 43° W.,

Corner is located in a barbwire fence, extending N. and S.

**GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

The lands included in the foregoing resurvey are located in mountainous country about six miles south-westerly from Dillard, Oregon. The elevation ranges from about 880 feet above sea level near the 1/4 section corner of sections 2 and 11 to about 1,840 feet above sea level near the 1/4 section corner to sections 11 and 14.

The area is drained by McNabb Creek and other tributaries flowing to Olalla Creek. Soil consists of a rocky clay. The lands are forested with fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, oak, maple, madrone, chinquapin, alder, ash, and yew. Undergrowth consists of vine maple, arrowwood, hazel, poison oak, salal, Oregon grape,
