ceanothus, rhododendron, huckleberry, salmonberry, wild rose, and ferns.

Access is gained by way of an asphalt surfaced road along Olalla Creek and a number of gravelled and dirt roads extending from it into the area.

There were no mineral deposits noted along the lines resurveyed.

The average of a number of reading gives a value of $18^{\circ} 00'$ E. for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of 1° due to local attraction.
