CHAINS

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S. $26\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 64 lks.
dist. mkd. N 1/16 S 35 BT.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. $83\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 128 lks.
dist., mkd. N 1/16 S34 BT.

Descend over NW. slope.

65.95 Leave timber, enter open bottom land, edge bears NE. and
SW.; also leave barbed wire fence, bears generally NE.
and S.

68.00 Long Valley Creek, 2 lks. wide, course S. 10° W.; asc.
over SE. slope.

79.52 Point for the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34, and 35, at
proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence
of the original corner.

From this point, the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34, and 35,
erroneously established by Akin, in 1972, bears
S. $2^{\circ} 57'$ E., 0.33 chs. dist., set, marked and witnessed
as described in the official record.

Remove the iron post, destroy the marks on the trees and
at the true corner point

Resettle the iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
