40.55	Gravelled road, 20 lks wide, bears N. 5° W. and S. 10° E.
42.15	Ridge, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.; desc. over SW. slope.
61.00	Gravelled road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 5° W. and S 10° W.
63.25	Ravine, drains SW.; asc. SE. slope, through fir and madrone trees with thick undergrowth.
66.95	Spur, slopes S.; desc. over NW. slope.
77.49	The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9.
	<p>N. 3° 08' E., bet. secs. 4 and 5.</p> <p>Ascend steep SW. slope, through logged area and dense brush.</p>
13.45	Top of ascent; continue over nearly level land.
14.55	Begin descent over N. slope; enter timber, edge bears N. and S.
21.30	Road, overgrown, 20 lks. wide, bears S. 65° E. and W.
28.35	Creek, 5 lks. wide, course N. 70° W.; asc. SW slope, through moderate timber and dense undergrowth.
